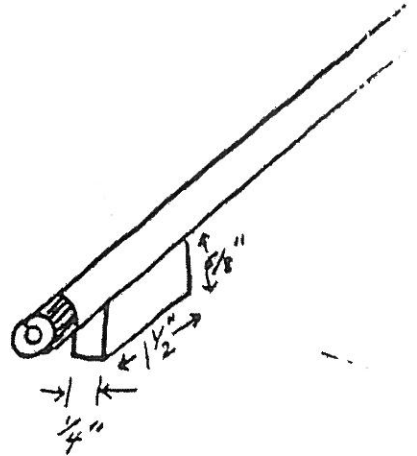


DOWEL BOW

1. Wooden dowel 5/8 inches in diameter and 14 inches long.
2. Block of wood, (size indicated in diagram) attached with strong glue 3/4" from end of stick.
(Some teachers use a domino)



Strong masking tape

BOX SUPPLIES

1. Empty margarine box
2. ~~Non-paint stick~~ (12 inches long)
Dowel (may need to cut to size)
3. Tape: Masking tape or a mailing tape
4. Box covering:
 - a. Patterned contact paper
 - OR
 - b. Solid color contact paper

If you choose "a," stickers can be used to decorate the box.

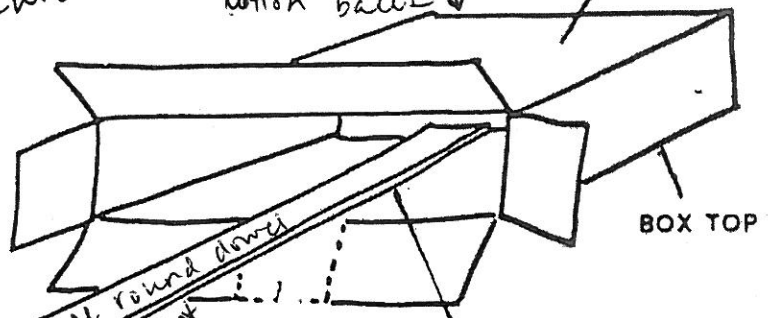
If you choose "b," you may draw the above violin pattern on white paper and glue on top of covered box.

- c. Cover with clear contact paper
This is optional, but necessary if you glue the violin pattern on top.

need a sponge on bottom -
don't slip, glue to wood = repair

stuff with
cotton balls

BOX BOTTOM



TAPE STICK SECURELY

CUT AWAY TO ALLOW FOR STICK

put little surprise inside
something they can keep in
their violin case + can use
in their learning. ie super
balls
for ball
balance

ASSEMBLING THE BOX

1. Attach the paint stick to the inside of the box with tape. Be sure to center it, and secure with plenty of tape. (See diagram.)
 2. Stuff the box firmly, but not so it bulges.
 3. Cut the flap to allow for the paint stick. Fold all ends in and tape securely.
4. Cover box with ~~masking tape~~ *masking tape* or *clear tape*
